BAPTISM:

Readings for Sunday June 20, 2021

Jb 38:1, 8-11/ Ps 107:23-24, 25-26, 28-29, 30-31 [1b]/2 Cor 5:14-17/Mk 4:35-41



In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells two parables designed to help us in our understanding of the "kingdom of God." In the first parable, Jesus says "this is how it is with the kingdom of God." Then he speaks about seed that sprouts, grows, and yields a harvest without the farmer understanding how it happens. The parable proclaims that God acts in our world as God chooses to act. We cannot control the action of God nor can we always understand or recognize what God is doing. God acts according to his own design.

In the second parable, Jesus says "to what shall we compare the kingdom of God?" He then speaks of a mustard seed "that springs up to become the largest of plants." Its growth is unstoppable. So it is with God. In the end, the dream God has for his creation will come to pass.

God is acting in the world. That action of God reached a definitive stage when the Son of God took on flesh and walked among us. That action of God continues. The fact we believe; the fact the Church continues, despite the sins of its members; the fact that good people sacrifice for the sake of the hungry and the hurting and work for justice and peace are signs that God is acting, signs that the kingdom of God is growing. As we pray in the Lord's Prayer, "Thy kingdom come."

Thank you to **ALL** who worked and participated in our Parish's Corpus Christi Celebration. The Mass, the music, the procession and the benedictions were beautiful and so reverent. Let us continue to show how we — the Body of Christ — extend the Eucharist into our parish and family life.

This weekend we are happy to welcome Bishop Michael Saporito. He will celebrate the 9:30am Mass with us. Let us give him a warm Ascension welcome!
