### PARISH MEMBERSHIP:

We welcome all new parishioners to our parish family. Every family participating regularly in the spiritual life of our parish is encouraged to register at the Parish Office. Please inform us if you are moving.

### BAPTISM:

It is mandatory to attend a baptism instruction class before scheduling the date for the baptism. Baptism is usually celebrated on the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 p.m. Parents must be registered parishioners and must attend pre-Baptism instruction usually given on the first Sunday of every month at 1:00 p.m. in the Gathering Room. Godparents must be practicing Catholics in good standing. Pre-registration at the Parish Office is necessary prior to the Baptism instruction.

### SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Saturdays 11:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Other times by appointment. Communal Penance Services are celebrated seasonally.

### MINISTRY TO THE SICK:

Please notify the Rectory of any elderly, shut-ins, or sick at home who wish to receive the Eucharist or Anointing of the Sick. Priests of the parish will be happy to visit parishioners in the hospitals in the area. Please notify the Parish Office if someone from your family is in the hospital and wishes a priest to visit.

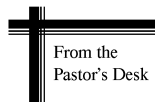

1 Kgs 3:5, 7-12/Ps 119:57, 72, 76-77, 127-128, 129-130 [97a]/Rom 8:28-30/Mt 13:44-52 or 13:44-46



Brad was a teenage boy who was "different". The principal was always calling him in for fighting or some problem. Brad's parents helped him get through this rough time because he was a generous boy with a good heart. One day, the principal angrily called Brad's dad into the office. "Brad's a troublemaker—he's just bad for the whole class." Then he dropped his bomb: "We just don't want a boy like yours at our school."

Mr. Connor stood up to leave and locked eyes with the principal. "All right. But if this school were on fire, Brad is the one boy you could count on to run back into a burning building—and save you."

Mr. Connor knew his son's hidden value, but the principal was young and a bit bossy—with no creativity, love, or time to "waste" on a troublemaker—when love and patient endurance was all that Brad really needed.

Patient forbearance on the journey is exactly what Jesus describes about God in the gospel today. God is not like an angry principal. God is more like Mr. Connor—willing to allow as much time as it takes for us to grow up spiritually—patient while we go through phases of immaturity and confusion.

God constantly steers us to the best choices, but if we don't listen, we end up sowing weeds, planting evil along with good in our lives. We must resist judging others, too, because we simply do not know what is wheat, and what is weed. "All human comparison is diabolical."

What about Jesus' sobering words on eternal damnation? Our future will be the outgrowth of our present desire to know and do God's will. If we give only charity and peace to others, we need never fear the principal's office!

Just a gentle reminder. Summer is the season for outdoor barbecues, beaches, and, of course, those well-deserved family summer vacations. While families spend hours planning ahead for those 3-day weekends and weeks out of town, they sometimes tend to overlook that their parish needs them even during the summer months. Envelopes are often forgotten.

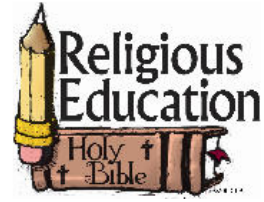

## ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK

### Directives for Re-Opening Churches

The guidelines below, given by Cardinal Tobin, apply to all churches and must be observed without exception.

1. Cardinal Tobin continues to dispense the faithful from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday & Holy Days.
2. In accord with national, state and local health directives, those who show symptoms of COVID-19 or who have been exposed to an infected person are not permitted to enter the church for 14 days.
3. Masks must be worn by all individuals while in the church.
4. Individuals must maintain social distancing (six feet) between each person while in the church.
5. A household may be seated together and not observe social distancing.

A household is defined as those people who have been living together under the same roof in close proximity throughout the quarantine. It does not include relative from other addressed or other extended family.

Note: There still will be a risk for anyone who attends a public Mass. Even with best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the coronavirus.

**In addition, here at Ascension until further notice, these additional directives must be followed for your safety:**

#### **Daily Mass and Week-End Mass Schedule and directives are as follows**

- Reservations will be taken on a first come, first served basis. **Please call** (no email, text, voicemail requests will be taken) the parish office, 201-836-8961 no later than 3:00pm on Friday. (If the office is closed due to Holiday, please call by Thursday).
- Mass will be celebrated at **8:00am** in the Church (Monday-Friday). Mass will also continue to be Livestreamed via Facebook.
  - Attendance will be taken and no one will be admitted after Mass begins (doors will be locked). There is a limited capacity of 80 people.
- Saturday morning Mass will be celebrated & Livestreamed at **8:30am** in the Church.
- Wednesday evening Novena will continue to be **Livestreamed only at 7:30pm**
- **Saturday Evening Mass will be celebrated in the Church at 5:30pm and on Sunday at 7:30am, 9:30am and 11:30am. Only the 5:30pm Mass will be Livestreamed via Facebook.**
  - Attendance will be taken and no one will be admitted after Mass begins (doors will be locked). There is a limited capacity of 80 people.

#### **All Funerals, Weddings, and Baptisms will follow the same protocol.** (80 person capacity)

-Enter side door near rectory

**-All visitors, including children, must wear masks, have and use their own hand sanitizer and wipes. Please wipe down area you have used and take with you any items you use.**

-Practice social distancing (6 feet apart). We have roped off pews not to be used.

-You may light candles, please refrain from touching other areas in church.

-Children must remain with adults at all times

-Bathrooms will not be open

**-Please** No gathering or socializing in church or on church property

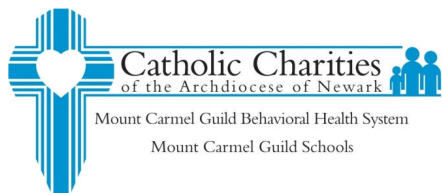
